**Directions to 5 A DAY Market Garden, The Street, Englefield, Theale, RG7 5EL**

**From M4 junction 12**

Take the A4 towards Newbury. At the second roundabout turn right onto A340. Go past the entrance to Englefield House. Turn left into Englefield hamlet. Look out for the roadside signs with 5 A DAY logo.

**From Newbury**

Take the A4 through Woolhampton. Approaching Theale, turn left onto the A340. Go past the entrance to Englefield House. Turn left into Englefield hamlet. Look out for the roadside signs with 5 A DAY logo.

**From Pangbourne**

Take the A340 south from the village centre. Go over the motorway. Take the second turning right. Look out for the roadside signs with 5 A DAY logo.
